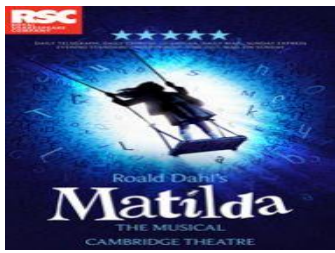

Thank you for your generosity.



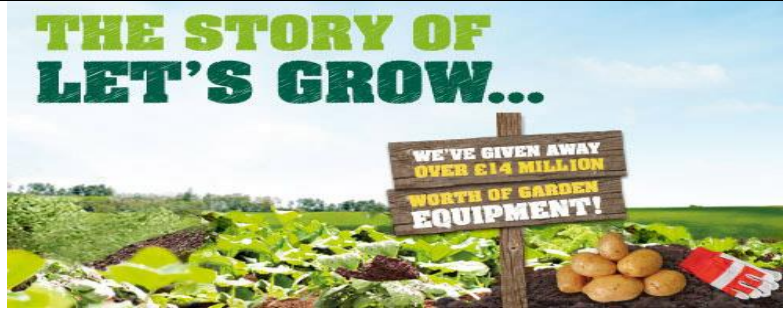
YEAR 6 TRIP TO THE WEST END

September to watch the musical 'Matilda'. As I'm sure all the children told you...what a wonderful time was had by all. A truly magical day.

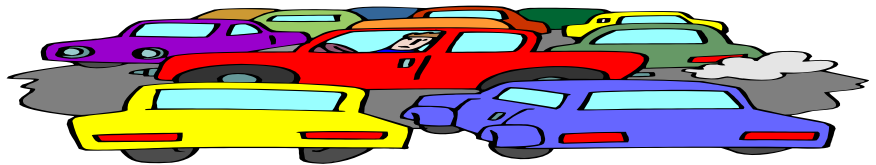
