For Parents/Carers and Visitors

As well as following guidance set out in our Home School Agreement and holding the above principles in mind, parents, carers and visitors are asked:



To respect the caring ethos and values of the school



To work together with staff for the benefit of their children



To ask staff for help to resolve an issue in a positive manner



To treat all members of the school community with respect



To listen to pupils respectfully and give worth to their opinions



To correct their child's negative actions; especially those that may lead to conflict-both on and off school premises



To accept responsibility for the actions of their children and support the school

It is important that our school and community remains a happy, safe place for all. To ensure this we will take necessary action against

- Disruptive behaviour which interferes with or threatens school operations.
- Inappropriate behaviour on school premises.
- Adults approaching other parent's children to discuss/chastise them over issues that have arisen in school.
- Threatening or abusive behaviour to another adult.
- Using social media platforms or other forms of communication in an abusive, disparaging or threatening manner towards other members of the school community.
- The use of verbal or physical aggression towards others in the school community.
- Smoking or the use of any other substances on school premises.
- Dogs being brought onto premises (with exclusion of guide dogs).
