Year 2 trip to Cadbury World

In the spring term, Year 2 will be studying *Brilliant Birmingham* where they will be learning about the city they live in as well as the Cadbury brothers and the success of their factory. To complement their learning further, we will be visiting Cadbury World.

The trip is booked for **Wednesday 12th March 2025**. We will be leaving school at 9:30am. We will leave Cadbury World at 2.15pm and be back at school at 3:00pm. Children will not need to take any money with them.

If your child usually has a school meal, a packed lunch will be provided by school. Please select lunch option on ParentPay. If you normally provide a packed lunch from home, please remember to send one on the day of the trip (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles, nuts or sweets please).

The children will need to wear full school uniform, with sensible shoes and a coat.

In order for this visit to take place, we would ask for a voluntary contribution of **£19.45** to help cover the cost of admission and transport. You may pay this all in one payment or in 2 installments of £10.00 & £9.45 if you prefer.

No child will be excluded from any activity on the basis of inability to pay by the family, however, if the school does not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, the trip will have to be cancelled. Please make your payment and give consent on ParentPay by 28th Feb 2025.
