



Year 6 Trip to Bewdley Museum

Dear Parents/Carers

Year 6 will be learning about World War Two when they arrive back to school in September. To support their learning, we will be visiting the Bewdley Museum on **Tuesday 7th October 2025**. They will discover what life was like as an evacuee, learn about preparations for war and visit a genuine World War Two air raid shelter. They will also learn about everyday life during the war, rationing and experience a 'blackout'.

If you would like to order a school packed lunch please note this on your reply slip or on ParentPay so we can order these in advance. Please feel free to send them with an extra drink to have throughout the day. If you normally provide a packed lunch from home please remember to send one in on the day of the trip (no fizzy drinks or sweets).

The children will need to wear full school uniform with sensible walking shoes please. We will be walking outdoors all day and so an appropriate coat for outdoor weather, which may be cold and rainy, is essential.

We will be returning to school at the normal time so pick-up will remain unchanged.

The cost of the visit will be **£17.75 per child**. Please complete the online permission form and make payment via your **ParentPay** account by **Friday 15th September** if you wish your child to take part in these activities.

If you are unable to access ParentPay, in the first instance we ask that you contact the school office for help with this. Alternatively, you can complete the consent form below and pay the £17.75 trip fee by cash. All cash must be in a named envelope labelled "Bewdley Trip".
